If you qualify please contact your local Small Business Development Center in taking the next steps to certify your business firm.

Is your firm at least 51% owned, operated and controlled by a minorities or women? Yes \square No \square	<i>If No, STOP!</i> All firms seeking MWBE certification must be at least 51% owned, operated and controlled by minorities or women.
Does the minority or woman owner exercise the authority to independently control the day to day operations of the business? Yes \square No \square	If No, STOP! All firms seeking certification must be able to demonstrate the minority or woman owners exercise the authority to independently control the day to day operations of the business.
Is this firm "publicly owned"? Yes □ No □	<i>If Yes, STOP!</i> If this firm is publicly-traded, then you do NOT qualify for this program and should not fill out this application.
Is this firm "owned wholly or in part by another company"? Yes \square No \square	If Yes, STOP! The other company may need to be certified first before this firm can complete this application. (Contact us for further information)
